Key Indicator Cases

The chart below presents the AHNS-approved key indicator case categories and minimum numbers for the AHNS-Accredited Head & Neck and Head & Neck Endocrine Fellowships.

These case categories and numbers are not meant to be comprehensive but are designed to be representative of the broad surgical training experience that AHNS fellows should all be participating in during their fellowship year. These are minimum numbers for each category, and every fellow's experience and level of competency with regard to each case category will vary based on their own ability and their training experience prior to their fellowship year.

These numbers reflect the fellow's participation as surgeon, or as teaching surgeon who is guiding a resident through the procedure after having developed sufficient expertise as surgeon; they do not include the fellow's participation as assistant.
